WHAT DOES MERCHANT CASH GROUP DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?		
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	The types of personal and non-personal information we collect, sell and share can include but is not limited to: Name, address, phone numbers, reference names and phone numbers, Social Security numbers, Driver's License numbers, Bank account data, credit history and credit scores, Demographic data, data about your online activity, Internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and/or clickstream data.	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Merchant Cash Group chooses to share information, and whether you can limit this sharing.
